REACH is a regulation of the European Union, adopted to improve the protection of human health and the environment from the risks that can be posed by chemicals. Powerbox, is fully aware of the REACH regulation and is working in close contact with its suppliers to ensure that the requirements are met. The company is continuously monitoring updates in the REACH regulation as well as keeping track on changes that occurs in the supply chain due to updated or new products.

Powerbox's products are "articles" as defined in Chapter 2, Article 3 (3) of the REACH regulation ("*article: means an object which during production is given a special shape, surface or design which determines its function to a greater degree than does its chemical composition;*") and do not, according to our best knowledge, release substances under their normal use.

Suppliers of articles must provide recipients with information on SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern) if those are present above a concentration limit of 0.1% on an article level.

Registration is required for companies that either produce or import into the European Union any substance in volumes that exceed one tonne per substance. Powerbox does not exceed this import amount, and will therefore not be required to register.
